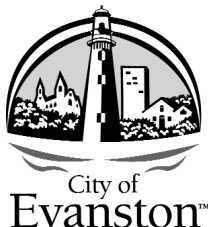
- \$** Learn how to reduce energy costs and manage heating bills this winter season;

- ◆ weatherization efforts;
- ◆ payment plan options;
- ◆ energy audits;
- ◆ winter heating safety.
